Merle Feld is a widely published poet, an award-winning playwright, an educator and activist. She organized and facilitated dialogue groups on the West Bank for Israeli and Palestinian women during the first intifada, and most recently facilitated dialogue at Seeds of Peace for Palestinian, Israeli, Egyptian, Jordanian and Moroccan adult educators and community leaders. Her highly acclaimed memoir, "A Spiritual Life," has just been translated into Russian for readers in the former Soviet Union and is also forthcoming in Hebrew translation.
